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<p>Your organisation Please describe your organisation and your areas of activity.</p>	<p>Our organization is a civic association based in the year 2016 in the northwest of Slovakia, and deals with, among other things, publishing activities.</p>
<p>Project idea Please give a brief description of your project idea, what you want to achieve and how you plan to achieve it.</p>	<p>The project is based on the presentation of Roma culture from history to the present to a wide range of audiences of all ages to Slovak and Norwegian audiences, especially in more remote areas of both countries in the following ways:</p> <p>Together with a partner from the Kingdom of Norway, we will hold a series of presentation seminars (workshops) on the topic of the project.</p> <p>The seminars will include performances by Roma singers, dancers, musicians and artists of modern art, experts on the history of the Roma in our country, in Norway and in the world. Experts will present the audience, from children, adults to seniors, with historical facts about the lives of Roma and their efforts to adapt to the various state institutions and challenges they have had to face over the centuries and how their culture has evolved. We will also pay attention to today's negative</p>

	<p>social phenomena concerning the Roma community, such as extremism and poverty.</p> <p>The event will be accompanied by the presentation of a new printed publication "Understand and get to know Roma culture through historical facts" (introducing Roma as skilled craftsmen), which those interested will be able to buy and also an evening outdoor screening (projecting on the wall) of Roma-themed films heaven, Roming, ...).</p> <p>Part of this presentation event will also be the presentation of the planned new mobile application and web portal - "G-psee" for searching, connecting and communicating Roma from around the world, in the production of which a specialized company will participate. The basic version of this portal will be free, but users will also be able to purchase a paid version, which will provide users with greater comfort and better features.</p> <p>Leaflets, posters, regional TV and the press will be used to promote the workshops themselves, with the distribution for different age groups being divided as follows: leaflets for children and young people will be distributed to pupils and students in schools, for seniors in retirement homes, churches. Adults will receive information about the presentation event via local radio, daily press, posters at stickers in municipalities, from regional TV channels, the Internet (facebook, ...), leaflets in public places.</p> <p>As part of the presentation event, we plan with the cooperation of at least 1 educational institution (primary, secondary school), whose task will be to obtain and process information about Roma culture through the eyes of children and youth and thus contribute to the overall presentation.</p>
